The above events will be run in the order named, but the time may be changed according to the number of entries, and contestants are requested to be ready in advance of the time stated.

School Figures will be drawn by lot, in accordance with the U.S.F.S.A. system, for both Junior and Senior events. Attention is called to certain changes in Championship regulations, particularly to the addition of another group in Junior events (inside counters and outside rockers), and the lengthening of time required for Men's Junior Free Skating and Junior Pair Skating from three to three and one-half minutes.
