AMID SUSPENSE from the first event Thursday morning to the final whistle Saturday evening, the 22nd Annual Mid-western Championships, held in Colorado Springs February 5-7 under the auspices of the Broadmoor Skating Club, were packed with beautiful displays of skating gyrations.

General and Mrs. O. W. Griswold entertained officials and judges at a lovely cocktail and dinner party at the Cheyenne Mountain Country Club for the first social event of the competitions.

Senior Men's school figures opened the championships Thursday morning with two contestants, Raymond Blommer and David Jenkins—David placing first. Novice Ladies with ten contestants followed, with Sandra Blair taking the lead in a closely-contested event. Robert James won Novice Men's figures.

Thursday afternoon Donna Abbott skated with beautiful precision over 19 other Juveniles to win first place. Juvenile Boys' figures followed with two contestants, Phillip Cagnoni winning over Hibbard Davis. In the final event of the day, Barlow Nelson placed first over Tommy Weinreich in Junior Men's figures.

The Senior Ladies' school figures opened the schedule Friday morning with 12 entries. Betty Lynne Stogner took the lead, with Mary Ann Dorsey a very close second. Delita Rodriguez placed third.

Friday afternoon's events consisted of Junior Ladies' school figures. Carol Keyes emerged victor, with Gladys Irene Jacobs and Carole Anne Carlson placing second and third, respectively.

First event Friday evening put the audience in an appreciative mood as little nine-year-old Phillip Cagnoni, Juvenile Boy, free skated into first place to retain his lead set earlier in figures. Juvenile Ladies followed with Donna Abbott, wearing a lovely blue velvet dress, skating a well-planned program to win the title. In the Novice Ladies' division which followed, tiny Stephanie Westerfeld "stole" the show with her skill and performance in an outstanding program to skate from fifth in figures to first place.

Saturday afternoon events consisted of Bronze and Silver Dance with four couples entered in each. Jane Holmes and Carl S. Chamberlin, skating with beautiful precision, style and grace wonderful to watch, won the gold medal in the Silver Dance. Delita Rodriguez and Harvey Dowlen skated into first place in the Bronze Dance with easy assurance.

Following the dance finals a social dance on ice was held for contestants, judges and visiting skaters.

Opening the competitions Saturday evening, Gladys Irene Jacobs in the Junior Ladies' Singles skated to undisputed first place in one of the most interpretive programs of the evening.

The Senior Men's title was captured by David Jenkins with a program that would take superlatives to describe. David, displaying great skill, executed intricate footwork mixed with a double loop, two double axels in succession, a flying sitspin combination, a double flip, a double lutz, to the outstanding highlight of his program when with great ease he landed a triple loop to bring great ovations from the contestants and spectators.

Susan Sebo and Lee Carroll Owen, who previously planned to enter Junior Pairs, moved into the Senior Pair division for lack of competition, and skated a well-coordinated program. However, the senior pair crown was taken by Kay Servatius and Sully Kothman. This handsome couple made a charming picture as they skated their program, showing a number

of difficult lifts, fine footwork and jumps, and ending with dramatic simplicity.

The Senior Ladies' competition provided a colorful climax to the competition, with Mary Ann Dorsey skating into the hearts of the spectators to win the coveted title.

Exhibitions were given by the winners of previous events. Children from the Myron Stratton Home, Christian Home for Children, and the Colorado Deaf and Blind School, guests of the Broadmoor Ice Palace, were especially entranced by the exhibitions skated by Stephanie Westerfeld and Phillip Cagnoni. Following the exhibitions, H. Kendall Kelley, President of the USFSA, Henry M. Beatty, and Carl Chamberlin awarded the trophies and medals. Lovely corsages were presented to all winning ladies.

The Broadmoor Skating Club, with a good balance of strength in all events, easily retained the Cleveland Skating Club Memorial Trophy for the second consecutive year.

At the conclusion of an exciting and inspiring competition, a buffet supper and dance was held in the main dining room of the Broadmoor Hotel.
